

Research & Development

Clinical trials - We provide our legal insight in navigating and overcoming legal and regulatory issues that often arise at all phases of clinical trials and observational studies.

Regulatory/Compliance

- Advertising and marketing We help ensure compliance with advertising and promotional rules in their application to various interactions with healthcare professionals e.g. grants and donations, sponsoring et cetera.
- Compliance Programs We provide assistance in the development, implementation, auditing and monitoring of compliance programs (e.g. FCPA review, Anti-Corruption practices) and SOPs. We are also experienced in preparing workshops on optimal internal practices to respond to dawn raids and investigations by various supervising authorities.
- Day to day Operations and Stand Alone Projects We advise major pharma and medical device companies on all their day to day operations such as (indicatively) commercial strategies, contractual relationships, distribution channels, pricing, IP Law, E-Commerce, Internet Policy et cetera.

We also prepare and file the necessary notifications to, and obtain the relevant approvals from, the Data Protection Agency.

Corporate Governance

- Corporate Governance We observe all corporate formalities on behalf of our clients and we engage in the drafting, reviewing and commenting upon corporate documents such as Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, Board of Directors and General Assembly Minutes, Partners' and Administrators' Resolutions, Prefecture Announcements etc.
- Dispute Resolution We represent clients in litigation, arbitration and other administrative proceedings effectively and in ways that protect corporate reputations and brands. This includes drafting and supporting recourses, appeals and applications before the Civil and Administrative Courts and Authorities as well as negotiating amicable resolutions before the competent authorities (e.g. SFEE).

Market Access/Commercial Practices

- Commercial agreements We negotiate, draft and review licensing, manufacturing, distribution and co-distribution, joint venture, branding, outsourcing, research, clinical trial, collaboration, co-promotion and other types of commercial agreements.
- Competition and trade We address the antitrust implications of mergers, acquisitions and other strategic alliances, practices and policies, such as discount and credit strategies.

- Public procurement We prepare and process files and documents for public tender procedures. We are currently representing a number of companies (both from the pharma and medical devices sector) supplying the public sector and have initiated, where needed, court proceedings on their behalf against various public legal entities.
- Reimbursement and Pricing We advise and assist clients in gaining, keeping and defending product eligibility for reimbursement and insurance coverage. We have initiated opposition procedures against price bulletins.

Research & Development

Reviewing, drafting and commenting upon clinical trial and observational study agreements; drafting and reviewing patients' consent forms and accommodating relevant GDPR rules

Regulatory/Compliance

- Acted on behalf of major pharma companies so far as the interpretation and enforcement of the provisions on rebates, claw-backs and entry fees are concerned; submission of recourses and petitions of annulment against the pertinent ministerial decisions.
- Advice on the conduct of market research activities and preparation of the relevant agreements and questionnaires.
- Advice on the national and EU regulatory environment concerning professional indemnity for healthcare professionals, interacting with pharma/medical devices companies.
- Advised on local regulations governing the return of expired products and the adequacy of products' reserves in the market.
- Assessed the eligibility of grants' and donations' recipients via the conduct of relevant due diligence reviews.
- Assisting and educating internal auditors in conducting compliance and audit processes.
- Conduct of internal training sessions and workshops concerning optimal internal practices to respond to dawn raids and investigations by the Competition Committee, EOF and other authorities.
- Drafting, reviewing and adapting to local requirements the standard operating practices (SOPs) including pharmacovigilance, interactions with HCPs, anti-corruption, best market and promotional practices etc.
- Established patient support programs intended to improve patients' disease education, lifestyle modification & adherence to medical treatment.
- Examined the actual formulation and operation of internet sites especially as to their compliance with Greek law.
- Advise and close collaboration with a world leading food company in the assessment, development, implementation and monitoring of a compliance program and the creation of operating policies for its Greek affiliate.

Regulatory Agency Processes

Review and assessment of promotional and medical information material in adherence to SFEE's Code of Conduct and the respective Circulars of EOF.



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- Supporting cases of wrongful classification of particular products as well as the respective recourses and objections before EOF.
- Notifications and licensing proceedings before the Data Protection Authority either related to clinical trials, market research or other activities.

Corporate Governance
